## PADDLE ADVENTURES ON THE SPILLWAY

A 45km stretch of the Selinda Spillway in the private 320,000-acre Selinda Reserve in northern Botswana.

Many travellers that visit Africa each year do not ever really experience a true, authentic adventure - exploring the wilderness in the same way that Livingstone and Selous did in days of old, immersing themselves totally in the living, breathing essence of Africa's wilderness, capturing the spirit of this amazing continent on a journey of discovery.

The desire from our guests to find the magic of the undiscovered has given rise over the years to requests for forays into territory only accessible on foot, far from the beaten track. And in 2009 Mother Nature gave us a way to fulfil this desire for impromptu exploration, thanks to epic floodwaters which once more opened the Selinda Spillway, causing it to flow in full for the first time in almost three decades of being bone dry.

The annual flooding of the Selinda Spillway now allows us to offer a magnificent, fully guided four-night, five-day canoe trail along almost 45km of this ancient waterway, fly camping on its banks at night and exploring its snaking bends by day.

## A CANOE AND WALKING SAFARI LIKE NO OTHER

The Selinda Canoe Trail offers you five days and four nights of unparalleled adventure on a canoe and walking safari like no other, taking you deep into the Spillway's islands and lagoons that cannot be accessed by any other means.

The stretch of the Spillway we traverse is well known for some of Botswana's largest herds of buffalo and elephant, roan antelope and the famed Explorer's pack of African wild dog. Other possible sightings include cheetah, lion and leopard, as well as the "usual suspects" of plains game.

### PADDLING AWAY YOUR DAYS...

Days are spent paddling gently along the Spillway; stopping regularly for breaks and walks wherever there is something of interest on the banks. Nights are spent in makeshift fly camps consisting of two-man 3m x 3m dome tents, which are prepared for you by our staff, as are all meals.

Each canoe has two guests, their bedrolls and bags. Guests should be strong enough to paddle their own canoes but no previous experience is necessary as tuition is readily given to beginners and novices. The only must is a desire to really explore wild Africa!

Fully inclusive of all meals, all related activities, limited but good selection of alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages and park fees. Feel free to bring your own favourite beverage at no additional charge if we don't have stock of it! Flights are additional.

Full day canoeing and bushwalks whilst on the canoe trail with a game drive airstrip transfer in an open 4x4 vehicle at the start and end of the Selinda Canoe Trail.

The 5-day/4-night Selinda Canoe Adventure covers approximately 45kms and begins and ends at the Selinda airstrip.
